

This Luxurious Villa in Prigadica is the perfect choice for true relaxation and indulging in a time of absolute hedonism. .








LOCATION

Average temperatures are rather high: the average annual temperature is 16.8°C, in the coldest month of January it is 9.1°C, in the hottest month of July 26.9°C. daily and annual temperature differences are small, which is very favourable for agriculture and tourism. There are many hours of sunlight, 2,700.


















The villa and terraces have a size of ca 1.100 m². All in perfect condition build with best possible natural materials.


